An intense, interactive parenting education program designed to provide services for children birth through 5 years old and their parents.

## **ACCOMPLISHMENTS:**

- 1,327 families with environmental risk factors worked with PB&J counselors and family intervention specialists toward achieving personalized goals that improve parenting, health and wellness for them and their children.
- PB&J has successfully reunified 88% of its families in less than 12 months, well above the federal Administration for Children and Families performance measure of 76.2%.
- 411 families (709 children) were provided a Christmas experience through PB&J's annual "Adopt-A-Family Holiday Wish" program.
- The PB&J in Bernalillo serves families in the far-reaching corners of Sandoval County, Jemez Pueblo, and Santa Domingo, Santa Ana, and San Felipe

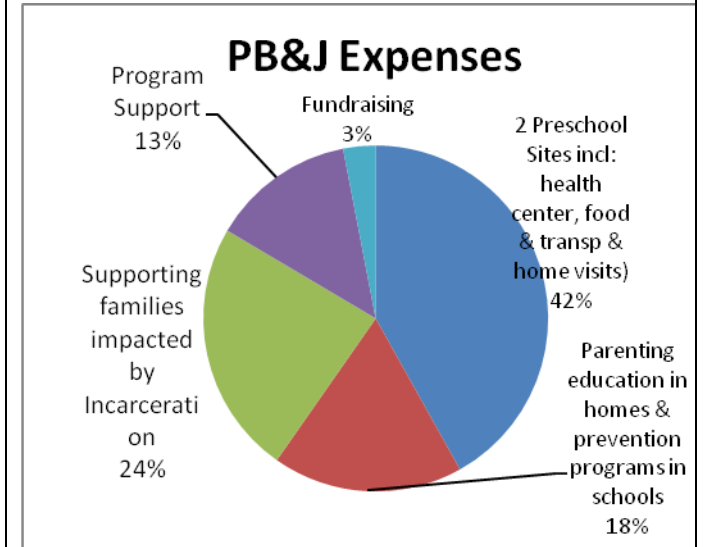
